Financial aid, such as scholarships and grants, can make college and trade school affordable. Use the checklist below to help you streamline your scholarship application process.

Below is a list of things you may need access to when applying for scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Tip: Gather these items and save them in one safe location, like a digital folder. This will save you time, application after application!

ACADEMIC

- High School or College Transcripts
- Standardized Test Scores
- Recommendation Letter
- Top College Choices
- GPA
- High School Code

PERSONAL BACKGROUND

- Contact Information
 - Full name
 - Address
 - Phone number
 - Birth date
- Student Resume or Brag Sheet
 - School activities: *Include any specific roles you hold in an organization or sports team, i.e. captain, president, etc.*
 - Community service
- Email address: *Be sure to use an email you check often!*
- Parents' names and employment
- Awards or honors
- Employment: *Summer jobs, internships, assistantships, etc.*

FINANCIAL

- Parents' income and/or most recent federal tax return (dependent students)
- FAFSA Submission Summary or FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR)

MISCELLANEOUS

- Scholarship Essay
- Portfolio
- Video Entry/Essay

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION STEPS

- Research your top college choices to find merit-based (AKA institutional-based) scholarship opportunities for incoming students.
- Create your own scholarship application goal and ask someone to help you stay accountable. (Adjust your goal to fit your schedule.)
- Create or update your Fastweb profile to get scholarship matches sent your way that you should consider applying for.

BEFORE SUBMITTING YOUR SCHOLARSHIP, CHECK THE FOLLOWING

- Did you proof all essay/video submissions?
- Did you use the correct address?
- Was your personal statement included?
- Did you attach/include every scholarship application requirement?
- Did the video require a social post and a specific hashtag usage?
- How many letters of recommendation were required?

Ask a teacher or peer to double-check your scholarship application “packet” before you submit it to ensure that you’ve included all requirements.
